Huang Rui is one of China's most highly regarded artists and one of the pivotal protagonists of the first non-conformist art groups to emerge from China in 1979. The Stars Group (Xing Xing 星星), established in the late 70s following the end of the Cultural Revolution, used art to promote social ideologies and initiate some of the first free art expressions in the Post-Mao era.
